Design Engineering

British-designed and made

Since 1820 Samuel Heath have been designing and manufacturing fine brass fittings in Britain. Perfect function and beautiful form combined with materials and finishes that delight the senses are just some of the values embedded in this long tradition. We believe in combining knowledge and design expertise, built up over time, with contemporary computer aided design to produce products which are thoroughly researched and skilfully realised. Scale, proportion, function and choice of materials are aided by the leading rapid prototyping technology. Your interaction with the interior fittings in your home should be a daily pleasure. CNC Programming

Tradition informs technology

The CNC machine is set to a definitive tolerance of seven microns for absolute machining accuracy, this combined with the diamond tipped, tungsten carbide tooling delivers superior quality time after time. There is more than this however. It is the mind and the spirit, of the CNC programmer, imbued with generations of traditional metalworking practice, that will make the difference. By combining the very latest in modern production techniques with time honoured craft skills we are able to manufacture products which are both beautiful in appearance and technically superior in their functionality.



Hand Polishing

There's no substitute for time

Craft skills must be learned through study, perfected through experience, passed on through the generations, master to apprentice. This is exemplified in Samuel Heath's finishing processes. The high gloss polishing of intricately detailed components, so vital to the requirement for a flawless surface finish, cannot be achieved by machines alone. It is the expertise of the Master Polisher that reveals the fine details and perfectly prepares the surface so that it is ready for electroplating. At Samuel Heath we understand that it is the lustre and radiance of an immaculate surface finish that adds so much to the enjoyment and longevity of our products - and that takes time.



Electroplating

True beauty is far more than surface deep

Our Master Polishers create a perfectly smooth surface with no imperfections. The quality of this substrate is crucial to achieving a perfect mirror finish in the electroplating process which is to follow. Depth, lustre and durability are all distinguishing features of our finishes. It is also what lies beneath the final finish that is important. At Samuel Heath the electroplating process begins with an initial coating of copper. Copper is not always applied when electroplating on solid brass, but we do so as it ensures durability. Before this layer is applied a great deal of preparation is involved during multiple washing and rinsing steps. The electroplating stages that then follow to produce the desired final finish are controlled by our technicians ensuring the optimum depth of metal to provide longevity and a flawless, beautiful appearance.







Quality Control

An eye for detail

The eye may take numerous forms. The aim is the same however; total quality control of every element at each stage of the manufacturing process. The eye may take the form of a state of the art coordinate measuring machine equipped with a highly sensitive, ruby tipped stylus designed to check each and every critical dimension of each product. At the same time the eye may be that of a craftsman or woman ensuring that complete assemblies are consistently right – every time, or conducting the final thorough inspection of each and every product leaving our factory. A reputation for quality is hard won – and easily lost. That's why we believe in the eye in all its forms.

Villa Honegg Hotel and Spa

When award winning design company, Jestico + Whiles, was commissioned to specify the interior of the luxury five star Villa Honegg Hotel at Ennetbürgen, Switzerland, the company set out to renew the guest experience in a way that would reflect the hotel's striking mountain setting. Combining contemporary design with the heritage of the beautiful period building, the inspiration found in the panoramic lake and mountain views from each bedroom has been used to create stunning boutique bathrooms for each guest, bringing an element of the hotel's grand setting inside.

Jestico + Whiles worked alongside Samuel Heath, using the dedicated service for

designers and architects provided through our London showroom at the Design Centre Chelsea Harbour. The service offers one-to-one support for any size specification project, from initial product selection through to project management. The team from Samuel Heath worked with the interior design company to specify the guest bathrooms and spa areas.

Fairfield taps and showers were selected for their classic motifs and rich character. Samuel Heath Fairfield showers are also featured in the spa, creating synergy between the wet room spaces.



Gravetye Manor

Nestled in the Sussex countryside, Gravetye Manor is a hotel that represents true British luxury at its best. Set in 1000 acres of wooded parklands and gardens, which were famously created by William Robinson, arguably one of England's greatest gardeners, the hotel is used by many as an escape from the hustle and bustle of the city.

When the hotel's owners, Jeremy and Elizabeth Hoskings commissioned Nigel Crawley, designer and project manager at Crawley Studios to undertake the redesign. With the great outdoors used as inspiration, the bathrooms have been designed in a way that ensures the space has been utilised in the best way possible. The Samuel Heath Fairfield

collection was chosen for its classic shape, with a modern feel, featuring soft sweeping curves. Combined with the luxurious feel of Fairfield brassware, the collection delivers a touch of glamour and elegance and fits perfectly within the hotel's redesign.

In addition, Nigel requested that the feature inscription from the hotel's main entrance was replicated in the bathrooms. Samuel Heath were able to engrave a 'G' in each of the taps, adding a personal touch.

Surrey Home

When Judith Arrowsmith from Thames Design Company was asked to design five bathrooms in a new-build family home, her vision was to tailor each room to suit its family member. With uninterrupted views of the countryside, the main bathroom has been shaped to make the best of the natural light with an open plan layout and bright neutral shades using natural materials such as limestone, travertine and wood. Bespoke wooden furniture creates a modern farmhouse style, whilst the luxurious curves of Samuel Heath's hand-finished brassware gives the room a softer aesthetic. The Fairfield collection has been used throughout the room with Fairfield single lever taps on the double basin and a Fairfield bath/shower mixer for the bath.

In contrast to the main bathroom, two matching en suites use charcoal porcelain oversized tiles combined with Samuel Heath stainless steel taps and shower fittings for a sleek and stylish edge. A simple design with a wet floor shower area keeps furniture to a minimal, whilst the external shower valves are located outside of the shower.

On the opposite side of the house, the children's en suite uses chrome finished taps and showers to accompany a light palette of sky blues and snow whites, which maximise the light in the room. The small, reflective tiles enhance the bright atmosphere of the room.
